

TRAWLER SCHOOL CANCELLATION POLICY

You've planned to attend our trawler school, booked months in advance with your preferred dates and boom, out of nowhere the unpredictable occurs scrubbing your plans to attend. Cancellations are one of those challenges no one enjoys when our season is so short.

Our cancellation policy has been structured to be fair and accommodating regarding our clients, instructors, and the day-to-day operations of TGL.

All balances are due 30 days prior to the trawler school commencement. If you must cancel 30 days or more of your scheduled trawler school dates, the adapted cancellation fees apply.

- Confirmed trawler school cancellations made 90 days or more prior to class date will result in a 10% deposit forfeiture.
- ➤ Confirmed trawler school cancellations made 60 89 days prior to class date will result in a 50% deposit forfeiture.
- Confirmed trawler school cancellations made 59 days or less to class date will result in a 100% deposit forfeiture.

> All cancellations must be submitted via email to TGL.

If you choose to reschedule your class and utilize your deposit or balance in the current year, the balance due, if any will be due upon rebooking your reservation. If you cancel after a second time, the total balance is forfeited. If you do not exercise your charter deposit or balance within one calendar year from the original class date, your deposit and or balance submitted is forfeited.
