DECK LAYOUT

The Nordic Tug 39 "Skye's Song" deck layout is straightforward and highly functional. The foredeck is easily reached through the pilothouse doors, with grab rails positioned above and forward of the openings for secure movement. Stout 1¼" bow and stern rails provide solid handholds throughout. Anchor handling is simple, with the windlass controllable from either the pilothouse or the foredeck. Side decks allow transitioning aft of the PH doors to the cockpit if necessary to secure fenders or a simple move aft outside of the vessel. Once in the cockpit, a ladder leads to the upper deck over the salon for an ideal spot for sunbathing and relaxing and excellent access to the PH top. The swim platform is accessed through the transom gate and includes a telescoping swim ladder for easy reboarding after a swim. Storage is well thought out, with access beneath the cockpit through the lazarette door, plus additional stowage in both port and starboard cockpit lockers. Fender storage is neatly handled in recessed pockets in the aft cockpit transom.

INTERIOR FLOORPLAN

The Nordic Tug 39 floorplan is a practical two-cabin, one-head cruiser with a bright, open main deck and private accommodations below. Entering from the aft cockpit into the airy main salon to port is an L-shaped settee which converts to a berth and dinette table arrangement comfortably seats four. Designed to keep the living space open while underway or at anchor, the galley is to starboard, positioned to serve both the salon and the pilothouse, and the large windows throughout the salon and pilothouse bring in excellent natural light and ventilation when needed. Forward and up three stairs, the pilothouse features a generous and dedicated helm chair with great access to the console and dash area with seating to port and the stairway down located between the seats, keeping traffic flow logical and secure. Below decks the forward stateroom features an island queen berth, giving the stateroom roomy feel for a boat this size. The guest cabin is opposite the head to starboard and configured with a large double making it ideal for visiting couples, kids, or extra gear on longer trips. The head is on the port side and benefits from a more usable vanity and countertop with an improved aft shower arrangement.
